Collaboration with ASA: Advancing the Anesthesia Care Team Model

As part of the overall Strategic Plan developed in 2024, ASATT has plans to work with the American Society of Anesthesiologists (ASA) in advancing the role of Anesthesia Technicians and Technologists within the Anesthesia Care Team (ACT) model. The goal will be to advocate for the proper placement and recognition of our profession within this team, ensuring that our contributions are acknowledged and integrated into the broader anesthesiology community.

Partnering with AORN: Education and Awareness

In addition to our collaboration with ASA, we have been engaging in important discussions with AORN (Association of periOperative Registered Nurses) to promote awareness about the Scope of Practice for Certified Anesthesia Technicians and Technologists. Through these conversations, we are helping to educate AORN members about the invaluable clinical, technical, and safety contributions we bring to the operating room and procedural areas. These partnerships are essential in strengthening interprofessional collaboration and fostering a deeper understanding of the vital role we play in the perioperative environment.

With membership at its highest level in recent years, ASATT recognizes the importance of expanding CEU opportunities, expanding Practical Experience Programs (PEP), and providing ASATT members with the resources and skills necessary for continued professional growth in the field. These efforts have contributed to the growth of 17.86% in overall ASATT membership numbers since 2020.



2024 marks the third year of membership growth for ASATT, climbing from 1,633 last year to 1,719, and increase of 86 members (over 5%). ASATT has a strong and growing community, and it's important to stay connected and committed to one another and to ASATT's mission. Continued growth in the future depends on all of us staying positive, engaged, and working together. 






2024 MEMBERSHIP POPULATION BY **GEOGRAPHY & REGIONAL TERRITORIES**







ASATT continues to remain in a strong financial position throughout 2024, which was the final year of an in-person Annual National Conference, which produced another significant loss of net assets. The Annual Conference represented 43% of the overall ASATT expenditures, yet only 14.56% of ASATT's income. ASATT ended 2024 with a net loss of \$63,937.42.




Financial Review cont'd

2024 RESERVES



In 2024 ASATT investments grew by \$49,092, which was about half of the positive growth ASATT experienced in 2023 after a significant loss in the value of investments in 2022. ASATT ended 2024 with a total reserve value in investment accounts of \$1,381,889.
